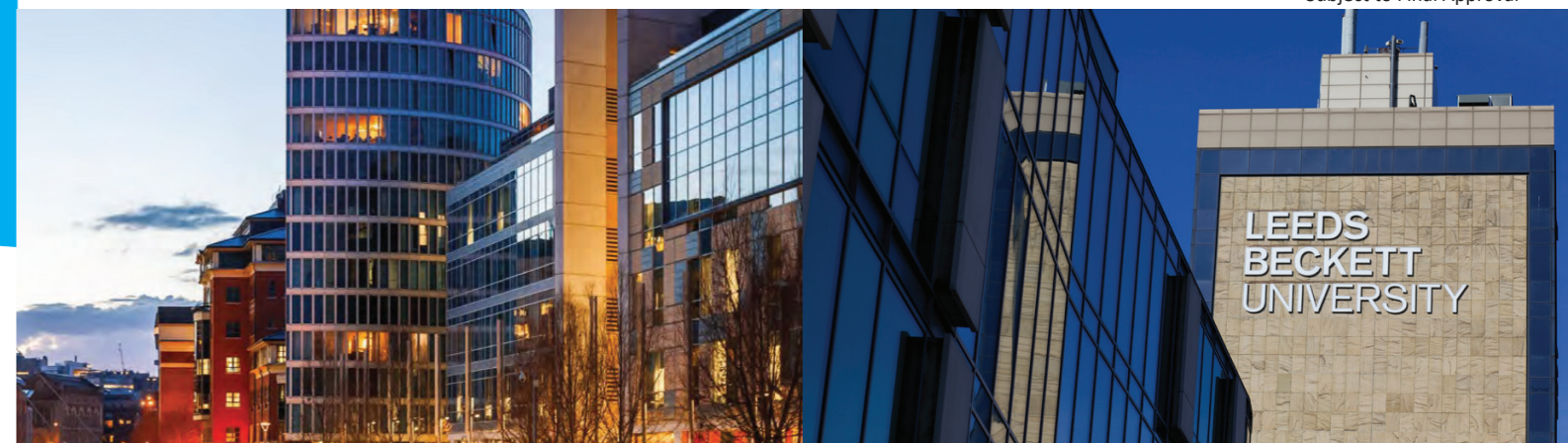


Leeds Beckett University (LBU)
