**Note:** All courses will be delivered at The British College (TBC) Kathmandu, franchise partner of above universities.

### **Eligibility:**

Prospective applicants must be from low income families or underprivileged backgrounds and meet all of the following conditions.

**1) Citizenship:** An applicant and his or her parents must be citizen of Nepal.

**(2) Age:** The applicant must be under age 20 as of July 1, 2018 (Should be born after July, 1, 1998).

**(3) Health:** An applicant must be in good health, both physically and mentally. Those with disabilities, but in good mental and physical health, are eligible to apply. Those with severe illness are NOT ELIGIBLE to apply.

**(4) Level of education:** An applicant must have plus2 or equivalent or A Level and be expected to graduate from a high school as of July 1, 2018. Those who have already achieved a Bachelor's degree or a higher degree are NOT ELIGIBLE to apply.

**(5) Grades:** An applicant must have either 75% or equivalent or UCAS Tariff Points: 96 points required. (Minimum three A Levels or equivalent, excluding General Studies).

**(6) English Language Qualification:** Applicants who have proficiency in the English language will be given preference (IELTS 6.0 with no skills below 5.5, or an equivalent qualification)

**Scholarship Benefits:**

The scholarship covers 100% tuition fee and maintenance cost for the entire study period. For further details, contact The British College Kathmandu, (977 1 5111100/01/2)

**Required Documents:** 1 set of the original documents below:

1. Completed Application Form
2. Letter certifying low income status. Must be issued by local government authorities.
3. Two Recommendation Letters. Must be from two separate recommenders. The letters must be written by someone who can give in-depth assessment on the applicant's abilities, including a high school teacher, principal, or academic advisor.
4. Graduation Certificate of High School. Those who are expected to graduate may submit a provisional graduation certificate of high school.
5. High School Grade Transcript (including a description of the school's grading system)
6. Certificates of Citizenship of the Applicant and Parents (Examples: a birth certificate, a government- issued certificate indicating the parent (-child relationship, a family register, or parents 'passport copies)
7. Awards (Optional)
8. Applicants with certified scores on their proficiency in English may be given preference. Some examples include the following: Proficiency in English: TOEFL, or IELTS Academic
9. Copy of the Applicant's Passport/Citizenship certificate
10. Copy of updated CV.
11. Any other evidence to support your application.

July 10, 2018	<b>[1<sup>st</sup> Round]</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The British College (TBC) announces call for applications.</li><li>• Applicants must check the announcement from TBC, including the deadline and submit the application documents to TBC in Nepal by July 31<sup>st</sup>, 2018</li><li>• TBC will scrutinize the documents submitted by applicants.</li><li>• TBC forward the application documents of selected candidates to TBC Vetting Committee by August 5, 2018</li></ul>
August 5, 2018	<b>[2<sup>ND</sup> Round]</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• TBC conducts the second round of selection through a vetting committee.</li><li>• TBC will conduct the interview of selected applicants.</li><li>• TBC forwards the application documents of the successful candidate to the Colt Foundation by August 15, 2018.</li></ul>
August 15, 2018	<b>[3<sup>rd</sup> ROUND]</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Colt Foundation conducts the final round of review for admission, and TBC notifies the candidate of the admission results by August 25, 2018.</li></ul>
August 25, 2018	TBC announces the final successful candidate on the TBC Notice board on <a href="http://www.thebritishcollege.edu.np">www.thebritishcollege.edu.np</a>
September 1, 2018	TBC informs the scholar of their scheduled arrival to Kathmandu. <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The scholar must check their travel itinerary and make preparations to reach TBC, Kathmandu</li></ul>
