Examination System

The AS and A Level final examinations are held twice a year in May/June and October/ November - the results of which are published in August and January respectively.

Grading System

Students are expected to take at least four subjects, including the English General Paper. They may take more than the required credits, depending upon their interests and capabilities. Students are assessed on a grade scale from A* (awarded for the highest level of achievement), to E (indicating the minimum required performance to constitute a pass). U stands for ungraded which is a fail.
